ACTION ON THE BUDGET IS CONTINUED UNTIL JUNE 1, 2009

Due to the uncertainty of local aid, the Selectmen, Finance Committee and School Committee have voted to delay action on the FY 10 budget until June 1, 2009. Although a session of Town Meeting is scheduled for Monday, May 11th, it is the recommendation of these boards that, if a quorum is attained, a vote is taken to move action on the budget to June 1, 2009, when it is thought that better information regarding local aid (which is ¼ of Abington's operating revenue) will be available.
