COYOTE SIGHTINGS IN ABINGTON AND WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

Recently there have been sightings of coyotes in Abington. The Animal Control Officer does not handle non-emergency coyote issues, nor does the Police Department – coyote issues are handled by the state Department of Fish and Game. More information is available at http://www.mass.gov/dfwele/dfw/wildlife/living/living_with_coyotes.htm The only time the Police Department or the Animal Control Officer can act is when there exists “an immediate threat to human life or limb”--this does not include coyotes that take domestic pets.
